DESCRIPTION OF AN AUSTRALIAN SUFFOLK

Object of the breed	To provide a suitable sire for crossing with other breeds to produce the ideal prime lamb
Ram	The ideal Australian Suffolk ram should be well balanced and proportioned. He will be free moving and of alert appearance with masculine outlook
Ewe	The ideal Australian Suffolk ewe will be similar, but with due respect to feminine characteristics and indication of good material qualities
UNDESIRABLES Head Legs Skin Fleece	Evidence of horns and eyes that protrude excessively Hocks too closely set Inclined to blue or spotted Black fibre or coloured wool throughout fleece. Black spots anywhere
Head	Hornless and black. Masculine for rams and feminine for ewes. Strong lower jaw with teeth meeting the bottom front pad. Ears not carried erect, preferably level with eyes, of good length and fine in texture. Eyes bright and full
Neck	Length in balance with body, blending smoothly into the shoulders with no depression at the collar
Shoulders	Shoulder blade should be slightly lower than the spine with no depression behind the blades, sloping to a smooth setting. Width of shoulders should be less than width of hindquarters
Back of loin	Back long, level and firm. Loin deep, firm, wide and well muscled. Ribs long and well sprung. Tail well set up
Hindquarters	Ample width and length between hips and pins. Well filled with flesh in the twist. Well muscled on the outer thigh
Legs, pasterns and feet	Black and placed wide enough to give sheep correct balance, with strong bone, woolled to knees and hocks, clean below. Pasterns to be short, strong and upstanding. Feet black and well formed
Skin	Pink in colour
Scrotum	Good size, well hung, carrying two normal and well developed testicles
Fleece	Downs type wool, dense and soft, firm handling and belly well covered. Suggested visual count 58-60s. Ideal micron 28-32. Free of black wool through fleece

A tribute to Patron Rex Egerton-Warbuton of Woolareen Suffolk Stud. 1928 - 2025. Summarised from the eulogy provided by his daughter Denise.

Rex was born in Kojonup on the 20th March 1928 to Reginald & Lena Egerton-Warburton. A legend now passed, he was the husband of Muriel Faith Welse from Katanning. Rex had 3 daughters; Diane, Denise & Maree, 8 grandchildren, 23 great grandchildren and 11 great great grandchildren.

Rex lived only with his father from the age of 4 and as a result he went everywhere with his dad; travelling to sales, dealing in cattle and sheep, and days at a time droving sheep and cattle on horseback; taking them to and fro the farm from Kojonup, Katanning and other local districts. He had an incredible memory, sharing stories from his past with family and friends over the years. Stories such as working in the shearing shed with his cousins, the Swiney's, rabbit trapping and roo shooting with his dad and uncle, washing super bags in the river and bringing marron to the home farm at the age of 11 to grow in farm dams.

After schooling, whilst home at the family farm, Rex attended many dances in Katanning. This is where he met the love of his life Muriel. They were married 12 months after meeting and in 1946 their first daughter arrived and family life began. Rex and Muriel (Moo) began their married life living together with Rex's father and his sister Dawn on the family farm 'Woolareen'. As his own daughters started to arrive, life became over-crowded all living under one roof and they decided to move to his 310 acre block 'Triangle Park' in 1951. They travelled back and forth to each property in the sulky, with their daughters at their feet. 12 years were spent living at Triangle Park originally in a tent whilst a weather board shed was built and then into the main house.

Life over these years was spent clearing land, running sheep, carting cattle, growing crops for hay and grain for animal fodder and milking cows; sending the cream to Mt Barker butter factory. Rex began leasing part of his father's farm and after his dad passed in 1962, the farm house was renovated at Woolareen and Rex and family moved back.

In 1963, Rex started a Suffolk Stud 'Woolareen' which over the next 60 years became a great interest for him and Muriel. They were members of the Perth Agricultural Show and attended many country shows also travelling to the Eastern States, Tasmania and New Zealand. Whilst he never showed sheep himself, Rex had great success breeding rams. The largest order he received from one buyer was 111 rams, sent to the Eastern States. Rams were also sent to Mexico and China. Rex worked on the Kojonup Show committee, having a large input into building the stud sheep shed at the showgrounds. He and Muriel were named patrons of the Australian Suffolk Association in 2013.

Rex was a determined person. An example of this; after wool exporters went broke, and he lost his wool clip and 12 months of income in a flash, he approached the bank to loan money so as to keep clearing the farm. Knocking back the suggestion that he borrow double what he sought, Rex worked out a budget, and he and Muriel did every ounce of work they could by themselves, giving up golf and going out. After catching up and paying off their debt within a quick timeframe, Rex refused to ever borrow money again, paying cash for all purchases thereafter, including real estate.

Rex was always going to retire at age 65 and they purchased a house in Albany in 1987 with this in mind. But guess what, retirement never happened! Later in years as he began to slow down they bought a house in Kojonup for him and Moo. After Muriel passed, Rex was still driving to the farm and back proudly keeping an eye on everything. A serious fall at the age of 95 meant Rex was no longer able to drive and going to the farm with Denise became very difficult, this was a huge challenge for him to overcome. After the fall Rex entered Sprint Haven for respite care and decided to remain as a permanent resident.

97 years of living in Kojonup and Rex saw massive changes; from transport by horse to man on the moon to life in the present day. He weathered many storms and had some rough years, however he never stopped telling historical and at times hysterical stories about his life and the lives of his Dad and relatives.

May you join your beloved Moo and take a rest in the long paddock.



CONSTITUTION AND RULES OF THE AUSTRALIAN SUFFOLK ASSOCIATION (INC.)

1 NAME

The name of the Association is the "THE AUSTRALIAN SUFFOLK ASSOCIATION".

2 OBJECTS

The objects of the Association shall be :-

- a) the encouragement of the breeding and improvement of Australian Suffolk sheep;
- b) by judicious publicity, to keep the merits of the breed before the public;
- c) the arrangement of classes at various shows and the recommendation of persons who, in the opinion of the Committee, are suitable for inspecting and judging Australian Suffolk sheep to the Agricultural Societies and others requiring such persons;
- d) (Deleted by resolution of a special meeting of the Association on 25th February 1991);
- e) to co-operate in every way possible with the Australian Society of Breeders of British Sheep and in particular to give assistance in regard to putting into force any rule safe guarding the purity of the breed;
- f) to promote fellowship amongst the Suffolk Sheep Breeders of Australia, and to further their mutual interests generally in so far as the breeding of sheep is concerned, and in all matters affecting the sheep industry;
- g) to establish relationships and to encourage exchanges with other organizations having similar objects, throughout the world;
- h) to do all such other lawful things that are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects

3 POWERS

In pursuance of its objects the powers of the Association shall include the following -

- a) to make regulations and by-laws not inconsistent with this constitution for the conduct and guidance of members and for the carrying out of the objects of the Association;
- b) to collect and establish funds, which are to be applied for the attainment of the Association's objects;
- c) to acquire by purchase lease or otherwise land, buildings, plant, equipment, goods, chattels and effects and all other real and personal estate in the name of the Association and for the purposes thereof and to let, sell, mortgage or dispose of and otherwise deal with the same and for such purposes to execute all such transfers, deeds, mortgages, assurances, instruments, writings and things as may be necessary or desirable;
- d) to borrow or raise and give security for money by the issue of or upon bonds, debentures, debentures stock, bills of exchange, promissory notes or other obligations or securities of the Association or by mortgage or charge upon all or any part of the property of the Association or without security and upon such terms as to priority or otherwise as the Committee shall think fit provided that the total amount of borrowing in excess of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000) in any financial year shall first be approved by the Association in general meeting provided that no money in excess of ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000) shall be borrowed except upon security of some realizable asset of the Association.
- e) to employ officers and employees and to pay them salaries, wages, gratuities and pensions.

4 NON-PROFIT MAKING

The income and property of the Association when so ever derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of its objects as set forth in this constitution and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise howsoever to its members provided that nothing herein shall prevent the payment in good faith or remuneration to any officer or servant of the Association for services actively rendered to the Association.

5 MEMBERSHIP

- a) (Deleted by resolution of a special meeting of the Society on 25th February 1991).
- b) Every candidate for membership other than candidates for honorary membership shall submit a signed application containing such particulars, information and undertakings as the Association may from time to time determine.

6 OFFICE BEARERS

- a) The Office Bearers of the Association shall consist of a President, a Senior Vice- President, a Secretary and a Treasurer;
- b) The Committee shall consist of the Office Bearers together with such other persons as may be elected by the Annual General Meeting of the Association;
- c) The members of the Committee including the Office Bearers, shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting and shall hold office for a period of one year, expiring at the conclusion of the next following Annual General Meeting;
- d) A retiring member of the Committee shall be eligible for re-election to that office and shall hold office until his successor is elected;
- e) The Committee may from time to time co-opt such members into its membership for such period and purposes as it sees fit;
- f) A quorum at any Committee meeting shall consist of at least five of the current membership of the Committee.

7 RESPONSIBILITY OF OFFICERS

Any Office Bearers or members of the Association who upon authority of the Association accept or incur any pecuniary liability on behalf of the Association shall be indemnified by the Association against any personal loss in respect thereof.

8 MANAGEMENT OF THE ASSOCIATION

- a) The management of the Association shall be under the control of the Committee of the Association who shall exercise and carry out all rights, powers, authorities and functions possessed by, vested in or exercisable by the Association;
- b) All meetings of the Committee shall be called by the Secretary on instructions from the President or on the written request of at least four members thereof;
- c) In the event of any elected Committee man being unable to attend a meeting, he may appoint a proxy, who shall have the same voice in the voting as the elected Committee man;
- d) The Office Bearers shall have responsibility for the day to day management of the Association between Committee meetings;
- e) The Committee may delegate such of its functions as it sees fit to any Committee member whether co-opted or elected.

9 ADDRESS OF THE ASSOCIATION

The address of the Association shall be the address of the Secretary, for the time being appointed.

10 MEETINGS

All general meetings shall be called by the Secretary on instructions from the President, or on written request of at least six members.

11 CHAIRMAN

The President, when present, shall preside at all meetings whether of the Committee or otherwise. In the event of the President being absent from a meeting, then the Vice- President shall preside. In the absence of the President and the Vice-President, the meeting shall elect its own Chairman and such Chairman shall perform all the duties of the President at the meeting.

12 NOTICE OF MEETING

Fourteen (14) days notice of all general meetings shall be given to members and seven (7) days notice of all Committee meetings shall be given to members of the Committee. Notices of all meetings committee or otherwise, shall be served by sending a written or printed copy by mail to the postal address of each member entitled to such notice. The notice shall state as fully as possible the matters to be brought up at such meeting.

13 FORFEITURE OF SEAT

Any Committee members absent without leave from three (3) consecutive meetings of the Committee shall forfeit his seat.

14 VOTES

Subject to any contrary provision in these rules all questions shall be decided by simple majority vote. At all meetings each member present in person or by proxy shall be entitled to one vote and in the case of equality the Chairman shall have a casting vote in addition to his deliberative vote.

15 QUORUM

A quorum at any general meeting shall consist of not less than ten percent of the member ship of the Association.

16 ADJOURNMENT OF MEETING

If at any meeting there shall not be a quorum within half an hour of the appointed time for the meeting, the meeting shall lapse unless a majority of those present shall decide to adjourn the meeting for a period not exceeding seven (7) days. If there be no quorum within half an hour of the time appointed for such adjourned meeting, the meeting shall lapse altogether.

17 ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

a) A general meeting of members to be called the Annual General Meeting shall be held in each financial year upon such date being not later than 30th June as the Committee may determine and in any event not less than eleven (11) months from the preceding Annual General Meeting;



b) The business of the Annual General Meeting shall be to receive the annual report of the President, the balance sheet, profit and loss account and trading account and the Auditor's report on such balance sheet and accounts, to elect members to serve on the Committee and the Auditor for the forthcoming year in accordance with these rules and to consider such other business as may properly be before the meeting.

18 **MEMBERSHIP FEES**

- a) The Annual membership fee shall be decided at the Annual General Meeting, and shall be due and payable by the Return Due date as stated on the Stud Breeders Annual Return & Subscription notice.
- b) No member whose subscription is in arrears at the 30th June in each year shall be entitled to vote at any meeting, be elected to any office, or otherwise take part in the affairs of the Association until subscription is paid.

19 **DETERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP**

- (i) The membership of any person may be terminated by resolution of the Committee if :-
 - a) he fails to observe these rules;
 - b) he is in the opinion of the Committee guilty of conduct which is likely to injure or discredit the Association or the members thereof or to defeat the objects of the Association;
 - c) any termination of membership pursuant to this clause may be revoked by a two thirds majority of the general meeting of the Association held next after the termination.
- (ii) Any member may at any time by notice in writing to the Secretary resign his membership.

20 **SECRETARY**

The Secretary shall:-

- a) keep full and correct minutes of all resolutions and proceedings of every general meeting and of all Committee meetings in books provided for that purpose together with a record of the names of members present at all such meetings;
- b) keep a register of members setting forth their names and addresses and the dates of payment of subscriptions;
- c) attend to all correspondence;
- d) keep a full and complete record of the names of members voting at each election of members of the Association;
- e) perform such duties as the Committee may prescribe.

21 **TREASURER**

The Treasurer shall:-

- a) collect and receive all moneys due to the Association and make all payments authorized by the Association;
- b) keep correct accounts and books showing the financial affairs of the Association with full details of all receipts and disbursements and other particulars usually shown in books of account of a like nature and present periodical financial reports to the Committee together with all bank books or statements;
- c) ensure all Association accounts are paid following their presentation to, and approval by the Committee at duly convened meetings.

21.1 **REGISTRAR**

The registrar shall

- a) keep a register of members setting forth their names and address and the dates of payment of subscriptions;
- b) maintain a copy of all rams registered for stud use;
- c) collect all relevant information for the preparation of the Associations yearly Flock Book.

22 **AUDITORS**

- a) An auditor shall be appointed and his remuneration fixed at each Annual General Meeting provided however that no Auditor so appointed being a member shall be entitled to be remunerated for his service;
- b) An Auditor appointed under this rule shall, subject to sub-rule (d) hereof hold office until the next Annual General Meeting;
- c) Any member who is a member of the Committee shall not be eligible for appointment;
- d) An Auditor may be removed from office during his term of office by resolution of members at an ordinary general meeting of which special notice has been given but not otherwise;
- e) If an Auditor shall be removed from office under sub-rule (d) of this Rule, another Auditor may be appointed to fill the office at the same general meeting at which the previous Auditor was removed and the Auditor so appointed shall hold office until the conclusion of the next Annual General Meeting but if no appointment is made the position shall be deemed a casual vacancy;
- f) the Committee may fill any casual vacancy arising by the death, resignation or determination of appointment of an Auditor previously appointed but subject to ratification by the Association at any ordinary general meeting;
- g) It shall be the duty of the Auditor so appointed at least once in every year to audit the accounts and other financial records of the Association and to report to members as to every balance sheet, profit and loss account and trading account presented to members in general meeting and every such report shall state whether in the opinion of the Auditor -
 - (i) such balance sheet and accounts are properly drawn up so as to give a true and fair view of the state of the Association's affairs, and
 - (ii) the accounting and other records examined have been properly kept;
- h) Every Auditor duly appointed as such shall have access to the accounting and other financial records of the Association and to the minutes of meetings of the Committee and may require from any executive officer of the Association such information and explanations as he may reasonably require for the performance of his duties;
- i) Every duly appointed Auditor whether a member or not shall be entitled to receive all notices of and other communications relating to any general meeting of members and every Auditor not being a member shall have the right to attend any such meeting and to be heard on any business of the meeting that may concern him as an Auditor;
- j) No officer member or employee of the Association shall hinder, obstruct or delay a duly appointed Auditor in the performance of his duties.



23 FINANCIAL YEAR

The financial year of the Association shall end upon the 30th June in each year.

24 INTERPRETATION OF RULES

Any question or questions from time to time arising as to the interpretation of these rules or any question arising on any subject within scope of the Associations authority not otherwise provided for, shall be decided by the Committee, whose decision in all such cases shall be final and binding on all members.

25 HONORARY MEMBERS

At the Annual General Meeting any person who the Association considers to have advanced the interests of the Association may be elected as an honorary member.

26 ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

Associate membership will be made available to interested persons subject to the discretion of the Committee of the Association.

27 ALTERATION OF CONSTITUTION AND RULES

The constitution of the Association shall not be altered unless notice of the proposed alteration shall have been given to the Secretary in writing at least thirty days prior to the meeting of the meeting of the Society at which the alteration is to be considered. The secretary is then to give at least twenty one (21) clear days notice to each member of the Society of the proposed alteration. A motion proposing an alteration is to be carried by two-thirds majority of the members present at the meeting of the members of the Association.

28 COMMON SEAL

There shall be a common seal of the Association which shall be in the custody of the Secretary or authorized persons. All deeds instruments and other documents required to be executed by or for or on behalf of the Association shall be executed by the common seal being affixed thereto and by at least two office bearers signing such deeds, instrument or document.

29 WINDING UP THE ASSOCIATION

In the event of the winding up of the Association, the funds and property shall be disposed of as the Committee shall direct, having due regard for the interests of the members of the Association.

- * (At a special meeting of the Society held on 25th February 1991, the resolution was passed that all references to Auditor in this constitution be replaced by the word EXAMINER.)
- * These alterations to the constitution were lodged with the Department of Corporate Affairs in March, 1991.
- ** The name change and alterations to clause 26 was lodged with the Commissioner of Corporate Affairs on 9th July, 1991. New certificate of name registration received 19th July, 1991.

APPENDIX REGISTRATION

The Australian Suffolk Association is to monitor that the policy of the appendix being shown for four (4) generations for infused Suffolk progeny is being followed. The fifth (5) progeny is deemed a true Suffolk.

Infused animals need to be identified with an A placed after the Ear Tag number.

The Australian Suffolk Association strongly supports ovine brucellosis accreditation and encourages members who are not yet accredited to familiarize themselves with the disease, understand its potential impact on flock productivity and learn more about the accreditation process through the DPIRD website <https://www.dpiird.wa.gov.au>

Ovine Brucellosis is a bacterial disease that affects sheep, primarily causing reduced fertility in rams.

Infected rams often produce lower quality semen, which can result in subfertility or infertility. Because fertility issues can have many causes, the signs of ovine brucellosis may go unnoticed.

Many breed societies, show societies and selling organisations require sheep coming to an exhibition, show or sale to be from an ovine brucellosis accredited free flock or to have been tested for B.ovis with negative results.

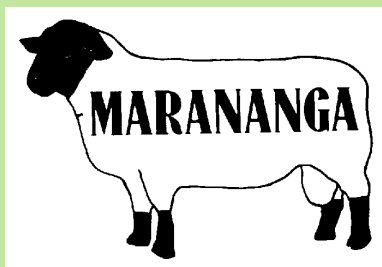

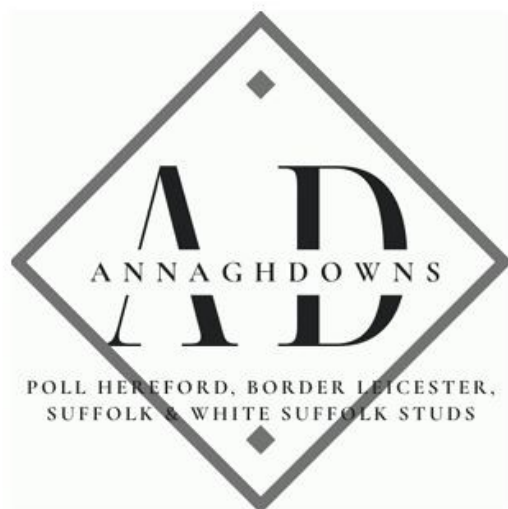
